



(肯定) **a few** + 複數可數N 「一些」 = some

1. **Few** students can get good grades on the test. It's too difficult for them.

很少學生能在這個考試中得到高分。
這對他們來說太困難了。

2. I need **a few** things to make fruit cakes.

我需要一些東西來製作水果蛋糕。
