1. Before reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Why did the cat like to be outside?	Because he was free there.
2. Why did the cat jump out the window?	For him, it was much better to be outside.
3. Did the cat miss the girl after he was outside again?	Yes, he missed his time with the girl.

2. During reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Did the cat like the lunch?	No, in his mind, his food was more delicious than the girl's food.
2. Did the cat like the bath? Why or why not?	No, he did not want to get wet.
3. Did the cat like the girl's clothes? Why or why not?	No, he did not like wearing clothes, and they were too big for him.
4. Why did the cat like the girl at the end of the story?	Because she treated him kindly and nicely.

3. After reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Do you like living in your house? Why or why not?	Yes. My house is small but comfortable. Also, I have a warm and happy family. My parents take good care of me every day. So, I am happy every day.
2. Why do people look at the same thing in different ways?	Because we have different family backgrounds. Also, we have different interests and life experiences.

1. Before dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. What did Mike eat at the festival?	He ate tacos, paella, Turkish ice cream, and pizza.
2. What kind of pizza does Mike like?	He likes pizza with a lot of cheese.

2. During dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Did Laura eat the cheese pizza?	No, she didn't. She didn't eat the cheese pizza.
2. Who ate rabbit meat?	Mike ate rabbit meat.
3. When do people say "poor you"?	People say so when they want to show sympathy to you.

3. After dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Do you like to try new food?	No, I don't. I don't like to try new food because I'm afraid of strange food.
2. Are you a picky eater?	Yes, I am. I only eat a few foods I like. No, I am not. I eat most foods and try new things.

1. Before reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. What is Alkmaar famous for?	It is famous for its cheese market.
2. Where do farmers put their cheese on display?	They put their cheese on display in the main square.
3. How do buyers and sellers make a deal?	They clap each other's hands and shout out the price.

2. During reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. In what season does Alkmaar hold the cheese market?	Alkmaar holds its cheese market in spring and summer.
2. Is it interesting to watch the traditional Dutch way of buying and selling cheese?	Yes, it is. It is fun to watch the traditional Dutch way of buying and selling cheese.

3. After reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Do you like cheese? Why or why not?	Yes, cheese is delicious. / No, I don't like its taste.
2. Do you want to visit the cheese market in Alkmaar in the future? Why or why not?	Yes. I want to visit the cheese market in Alkmaar because the traditional way of buying and selling cheese sounds interesting.

Dialogue

1. Before dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Who is in the dialogue?	Tina Tuna, her classmates, neighbors, family, and Tommy Turtle.
2. What happened to Tina Tuna?	That morning, a giant fishing boat took her classmates, neighbors, and family away.
3. Why didn't the giant boat catch Tina Tuna?	Because Tina swam the fastest.
4. What advice did Tommy Turtle give to Tina Tuna in the end?	Go find somewhere safer.

2. During dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Why did Tommy Turtle say "don't swim too fast" to Tina Tuna?	He was afraid he couldn't catch up with her, and couldn't look after her.
2. What is Tommy Turtle like? Use at least one adjective to say something about him, and tell the class the reason.	He is kind, warm, generous, helpful, encouraging, and reliable. He helped a stranger.
3. When do people say "that was lucky"?	People say it when something bad almost happened, but they tried hard to avoid it.

3. After dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. What will happen next? Please make up a new ending for the story.	Tommy Turtle and Tina Tuna will swim together and find a safe place.
2. If you were Tina Tuna, would you keep yourself safe or go look for your family? Why?	I'd stay with Tommy Turtle. Because the sea is dangerous.
3. There are fewer fish in the ocean now. What will happen if fishermen overfish?	Some fish might disappear. People will have less food.

1. Before reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Where is Tina Tuna from?	She is from the sea.
2. What are animals in the ocean asking for?	They're asking for a chance to live more safely.

2. During reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. According to the reading, what is the first problem?	Many little fish do not have a chance to grow up because humans' boats take them away.
2. According to the reading, what is the second problem?	The stinky oil and dirty water make it hard for animals in the ocean to breathe.
3. According to the reading, what is the third problem?	The colorful trash makes animals sick and die.

3. After reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Where might the dirty water come from?	It might come from humans' houses or factories.
2. What might the colorful trash be?	Plastic bags, bottles and straws.
3. Why do we need to help ocean animals?	We share the same Earth. It is important to protect all the animals on the Earth.

1. Before dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Where are Owen and Anna from?	They are from America.
2. What fruits can Owen and Anna buy right now in Taiwan?	They can buy mangoes, watermelons, bananas, guavas, papayas, or peaches.
3. What makes Taiwan a fruit paradise?	It's because of the good climate and skillful farmers.
4. Where can Owen and Anna buy fruit in Taiwan?	They can buy fruit at a traditional market or a supermarket.

2. During dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. How do Owen and Anna feel at the end of the dialogue? How do you know?	They feel excited to eat Taiwan's fruits because they say "That's great! We can't wait to try them!"
2. What does "everything" mean in "We want to try everything before we go back to the USA."?	"Everything" means the fruits in season now, like watermelons, bananas, guavas, papayas, and peaches.

3. After dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. What fruits would you want to give to your foreign friends to try?	I would give them papayas and pineapples.
2. Which fruits are you scared of trying? Why?	I am scared of trying durians because they smell terrible.

1. Before reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. When can we find fresh fruit in Taiwan?	At any time of the year, we can find fresh fruit in Taiwan.
2. Who helps make the fruit in Taiwan better?	Skillful farmers help make the fruit better.
3. When did Mr. Chen start the Known-You Seed Company?	He started the company in 1968.
4. How many kinds of watermelon seeds did the company create?	They created more than 300 kinds of watermelon seeds.

2. During reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Why do people call Mr. Chen the “Watermelon King”?	(1) He helped make watermelons taste better. (2) He helped create over 300 kinds of watermelon seeds. (3) He helped farmers grow better watermelons.
2. What makes Taiwan a fruit paradise?	The good climate and skillful farmers’ hard work make Taiwan a fruit paradise.

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Can you name any famous Taiwanese fruits?	Taiwanese mangoes, pineapples, and bananas are famous in the world.

Dialogue

1. Before dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Where are the students?	They are at the science museum.
2. What do the students see on TV?	They see trains and some people.
3. How do they find the answers?	They find the answers by looking at a sign.
4. Why is the blue train quieter and faster than the other one?	People changed the design of the train by copying a bird.

2. During dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. When David says “Let’s read it ...”, what does “it” mean?	It means the sign.
2. When Sally says “That’s so cool.”, what does “that” mean?	The special shape also helps the trains run faster than before.

3. After dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. People use the shape of animals’ bodies to make useful things. Please look up one more example on the Internet and share it with the class.	They copied insects and made robots.
2. Do you ever take the Taiwan High Speed Rail or train?	Yes, I took one last year. The THSR is really fast!

1. Before reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. What is Biomimicry about?	Biomimicry is about copying from animals and plants.
2. Why do people learn from nature?	They learn from nature and create useful things to make their lives better.
3. What makes the shark swim faster than other fish?	It has special scales from tip to tail. The shape of the scales helps the shark move through the water more easily and faster.

2. During reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. What might be there on the new swimsuit?	There might be something like shark scales.
2. What does “Nature is the best teacher.” mean?	There are so many things we can learn from nature.

3. After reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Can you also name something we could learn from animals?	There are so many things. For example, most animals do not damage the earth. Besides, they just take what they need and they do not overuse resources.

Questions	Sample Answers
1. What is Zoe holding? What does it look like?	She is holding a key chain. It has a raven on it.
2. What does the man in uniform do in the Tower of London?	He takes care of the ravens and gives tours to the public.

2. During dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. What kind of stories is Tony interested in?	He is interested in ghost stories.

3. After dialogue

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Do you have any questions to ask Zoe about her trip to London? If yes, what will you ask?	Did you hear any interesting stories about the Tower of London or the ravens? (參考答案)

1. Before reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. What do many people around the world think about ravens?	For many people around the world, ravens are ugly and bring bad luck.
2. How many ravens are there at the Tower of London?	There are seven ravens at the tower now.

2. During reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. What might “the kingdom will fall” mean?	The kingdom will end.
2. For the British, do ravens bring bad luck?	No, the raven is an important bird in their history. They are the protector of the kingdom.

3. After reading

Questions	Sample Answers
1. Do you like black birds? Why or why not?	No, I don't like black birds because I do not like the color black.
2. Why do people from different places think about ravens in different ways?	Maybe it is because people have different cultural backgrounds.
