Questions 38-39

Washing your hands is more important than wearing a mask to prevent disease, said Miu Wei-chieh, a doctor at Mennonite Christian Hospital in Hualien.

Both “wet wash” and “dry wash” methods can help prevent people from catching a virus, Miu said. A wet wash is washing one's hands under running water with soap and scrubbing for more than a minute so one's hands are very clean. Using only warm water has no effect. A dry wash is using an alcohol-based hand cleaner to clean one's hands. People visiting a hospital, or who have a serious illness, should wear masks, Miu said.

Dr. Chen Wei-po said that masks can be reused by the same wearer if the masks do not get wet and are not worn for more than four to six hours in hospitals. Doctors say that masks can be sterilized by exposing both sides of the mask to ultraviolet (UV) light for 30 minutes. One can also use spraying alcohol on both sides of the mask if the mask is not damaged or contaminated.

White House Easter Egg Roll

Since 1878, children aged 12 years and younger together with their parents have enjoyed egg rolling on the South Lawn of the White House on Easter Monday. Egg rolling is a custom of European origin where children roll hard-boiled eggs across the lawn with long-handled spoons. The first egg rollings were held during the Presidency of Andrew Johnson in the 1870s. At first, the Easter Egg Roll started on the grounds of the United States Capitol, but in 1876 members of Congress stopped people from using the Capitol grounds for the activity because it would be bad for the lawns. The following year it was raining on Easter Monday, so the children had to play some indoor games. It is said that a few days before Easter in 1878, President Hayes and his wife, Lucy, started to welcome the children to roll eggs on the South Lawn of the White House.

Since then, several US Presidents have brought many activities to this celebration. In 1889, music became part of the event when President Harrison invited the US Marine Band to play for the guests. They even composed the song “Easter Monday on the White Lawn” for this special occasion. In 1933, first Lady Eleanor Roosevelt used radio to welcome the coming people. The Easter Bunny was the first present at the Easter Egg Roll in 1974, during the Presidency of Richard Nixon, when one member of Pat Nixon's staffs dressed up in a life-sized bunny

costume. President Reagan first used autographed eggs for hiding in the Egg Hunt. In 1998, during the Presidency of Bill Clinton, the Egg Roll was first broadcast on the Internet. Barack and Michelle Obama first offered free tickets for the Egg Roll online in 2009. Today, besides egg rolling, the guests can enjoy food, games, sports, live music or storytelling. In 2010, the writer J.K. Rowling read from her book “Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone” and President Obama read from the book “Green Eggs and Ham” by Dr. Seuss. At the end of the event every egg roller gets a wooden egg signed by the President and First Lady as a gift.
