





Most English words are made up of smaller elements: roots, prefixes, and suffixes. If you learn the root word, you can work out many other words by adding prefixes and suffixes. Prefixes and suffixes cannot stand alone as words. Prefixes are a letter or a group of letters that we add to the beginning of a word to change the meaning of the word. For example, the prefix *un-* can mean "not." Adding *un-* to the word "happy" gives you the word "unhappy," which means "not happy." Here is a list of prefixes.

prefix	meaning	example
im-	not, without	impossible
re-	again	recycle, rewrite
uni-	one	uniform, unique
bio-	life	biology, biomimicry
kilo-	1,000	kilogram
tele-	far	television, telephone

Like prefixes, there are many suffixes used in English language. Suffixes are a letter or a group of letters added to the end of a word not only to change the word's meaning but also to show the word's part of speech. Here is a list of suffixes.

-ful	full of	beautiful
-s, -es	more than one	apples, boxes
-less	without	careless
