? Taking Vitamin C can keep us from getting COVID-19.

X Wrong. A doctor in the USA said taking vitamin C might keep us from catching a cold, but it's just an argument. We still need more studies to support this argument. Besides, you will still catch a cold even though you take vitamin C every day, but luckily, you might get well sooner than those who don't take it.

It seems that more children in Asian cities wear glasses than children living elsewhere. Is it because Asian people have more vision problems? A scientist, Dr. Morgan, studied this phenomenon and found some interesting facts.

Indian kids in Singapore wear glasses as much as the other kids in Singapore. But for those Indian kids who grow up in India, they don't wear glasses that much. Meanwhile, Chinese kids in Australia wear glasses about as much as the other kids in Australia. So, being Asian is not the reason. There must be something else that causes this problem.

Some people say that time spent on reading or looking at small things very closely are the reasons. But, it is not true, according to Dr. Morgan. His answer is light, both any light and sunlight. He says that going out in the sun and looking around are good for our eyes. He even compared two groups of children. One group spent lots of time doing outdoor activities. The other group didn't. The result showed that the first group had better vision than the second group. But there's still one problem: The sunlight in both Hong Kong and Singapore is bright all year long. However, why would children in these two cities have worse vision? Dr. Morgan says that children in Singapore don't like to spend time going outside because it is a tropic place. And children in Hong Kong don't have enough space to play outside. Furthermore, in these two places, it's very common for parents to tell their children to study hard. Therefore, these children would not spend much time on outdoor activities.

In fact, we all need sunlight. When we go outside and get some sunlight, something good happens in our body. Vitamin D will be created, and it helps make our bones stronger and our immune system more powerful to fight against diseases. So, getting enough sunlight is very important, for our vision and body.
